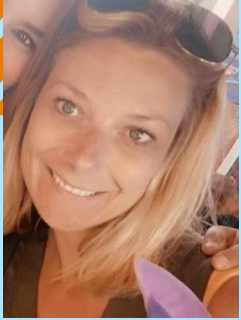


Suzanna Hoffman: our MC from WFWP
