

Schools For Future – NSW 2025



Schools For Future (SFF) is an Australian charity, registered with the ACNC, dedicated to achieving educational equity for marginalised children, aligning with UN Sustainable Development Goals 4 (Quality Education) and 10 (Reduced Inequalities).

Addressing Marginalisation: SFF recognises that barriers to education stem from factors like linguistic inadequacy, disability, ethnicity, and gender bias. They specifically target students from recently arrived families with low economic status and non-English speaking backgrounds, who often experience malnutrition and academic struggles.

Providing Direct Support:

- SFF offers sponsorships to cover essential needs such as daily food, school uniforms, equipment, and extracurricular activities, addressing immediate barriers to learning.
- They construct schools in remote or underfunded communities, having built 2 preschools in Vietnam (2022-2023) and 1 primary school in Uganda (2023).
- They facilitate socio-cultural skills development to improve students' integration and confidence.

Strategic Partnerships and Impact:

- SFF collaborates with schools and organisations, including The Smith Family, for student referrals and support planning.
- They provided 30 scholarships in Southwest Sydney in 2024 and aim to provide 60-80 scholarships in 2025.
